



# *Bunny Babies*

*for our little ones with love*

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### **Materials needed:**

- 2,0 mm crochet hook
- sport weight cotton yarn in white for the bunny's head, arms, legs and back part of ears. Color of your choice for the body part, left over yarns for front parts of ears.
- Stuffing of your choice
- cotton darning needle for closing and sewing the last round
- safety eyes or sew on eyes 7-8 mm
- tiny bit of pink embroidery floss, but if you don't have any, tiny bit of pink yarn will work as well
- eye shadow, powder blush, chalk or crayons in light pink; all these will work great to add little color to cheeks
- 5 mm/12-15 inches (30-40 cm) long ribbon in color of your choice.

### **Finished size:**

Sitting from bottom to top of bunny's ears 6 inches approximately (15 cm)

### **Gauge:**

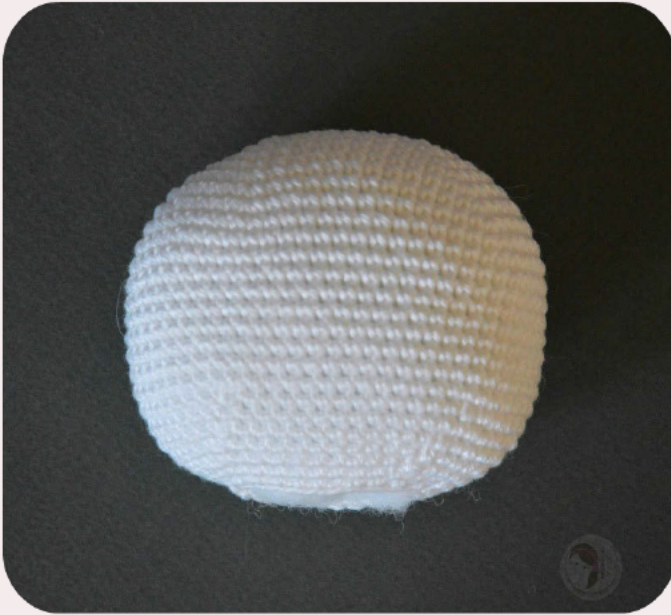
7 rounds x 6 stitches in 1 square inch (2,5 cm)

### **Abbreviations:**

*(US terminology)*

st(s)	stitches
sl st	slip stitch
sc	single crochet
ch	chain
hdc	half double crochet
inc	increasing stitch (2 single crochet stitches worked in one stitch)
dec	decreasing stitch (two stitches together, invisible decrease used in this pattern)
pop corn	single popcorn stitch, started from ch4 is used when making tail.
FO	fasten off

*Work in continuous rounds unless otherwise specified.*



## ***Bunny's Head***

work with white color yarn

chain 9

Round 1: sc7, 3sc in the last chain st, sc6, inc into last ch st (18 sts) for more info and photos look at the end of the pattern

Round 2: inc, sc6, inc x3, sc6, inc x2 (24 sts)

Round 3: sc, inc, sc7, (inc, sc) x3, sc6,

inc, sc, inc (30 sts)

Round 4: sc2, inc, sc8, (inc, sc2) x3, sc6, inc, sc2, inc (36 sts)

Round 5: sc3, inc, sc9, (inc, sc3) x3, sc6, inc, sc3, inc (42 sts)

Round 6: sc4, inc, sc10, (inc, sc4) x3, sc6, inc, sc4, inc (48 sts)

Round 7: sc5, inc, sc11, (inc, sc5) x3, sc6, inc, sc5, inc (54 sts)

Round 8: sc6, inc, sc12, (inc, sc6) x3, sc6, inc, sc6, inc (60 sts)

Round 9:

to Round 18 sc 60 sts (10 rounds)

Place your eyes between rounds 13-14, leaving 9 stitches between them.

Round 19: sc6, dec, sc12, (dec, sc6) x3, sc6, dec, sc6, dec (54 sts)

Round 20: sc 54 sts

Round 21: sc5, dec, sc11, (dec, sc5) x3, sc6, dec, sc5, dec (48 sts)

Round 22: sc4, dec, sc10, (dec, sc4) x3, sc6, dec, sc4, dec (42 sts)

Round 23: sc3, dec, sc9, (dec, sc3) x3, sc6, dec, sc3, dec (36 sts)

Round 24: sc2, dec, sc8, (dec, sc2) x3, sc6, dec, sc2, dec (30 sts)

Round 25: sc2, dec, sc8, (dec, sc2) x3, sc6, dec, sc2, dec (24 sts)

FO, stuff the head nice and firm.



## ***Bunny's Body***

work with color of your choice  
for the body

chain 9

- Round 1: sc7, 3sc in the last chain st,  
sc6, inc into last ch st (18  
sts)
- Round 2: inc, sc6, inc x3, sc6, inc x2  
(24 sts)
- Round 3: sc, inc, sc7, (inc, sc) x3, sc6,  
inc, sc, inc (30 sts)
- Round 4: sc2, inc, sc8, (inc, sc2) x3,  
sc6, inc, sc2, inc (36 sts)

Round 5: sc3, inc, sc9, (inc, sc3) x3, sc6, inc, sc3, inc (42 sts)

Round 6: sc4, inc, sc10, (inc, sc4) x3, sc6, inc, sc4, inc (48 sts)

Round 7

to Round14      sc 48 sts (8 rounds)

Round 15: sc4, dec, sc10, (dec, sc4) x3, sc6, dec, sc4, dec (42 sts)

Round 16: sc 42 sts

Round 17: sc3, dec, sc9, (dec, sc3) x3, sc6, dec, sc3, dec (36 sts)

Round 18: sc 36 sts

Round 19: sc2, dec, sc8, (dec, sc2) x3, sc6, dec, sc2, dec (30 sts)

Round 20: sc 30 sts

Round 21: sc2, dec, sc8, (dec, sc2) x3, sc6, dec, sc2, dec (24 sts)

Round 22: sc 24 sts

FO leaving long end for sewing body and head together.  
Stuff the body nice and firm



## **Bunny's Arms**

(make two)

work with white color yarn

chain 6

- Round 1: sc4, 3sc in last chain st, continue working around chain, sc3, inc last ch st (12 sts)  
Round 2: inc, sc3, inc x3, sc3, inc x2 (18 sts)  
Round 3: sc18 sts  
Round 4: sc6, dec x3, sc6 (15 sts)  
Round 5: sc15 sts  
Round 6: sc4, dec x3, sc5 (12 sts)

Round 7

to Round 10: sc12 sts

Round 11: dec, sc3, inc x2, sc3, dec (12 sts)

Round 12: repeat round 11

Round 13: repeat round 11

Round 14: sc12 sts

Fasten off leaving long end for sewing arm on the body later. Stuff the arm.  
Top of arm leave empty or stuffed lightly.



## **Bunny's Legs**

(make two)

work with white color yarn

chain 6

- Round 1: sc4, 3sc in last chain st, continue working around chain, sc3, inc last ch st (12 sts)  
Round 2: inc, sc3, inc x3, sc3, inc x2

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(18 sts)

Round 3: sc, inc, (inc, sc) x3, sc3, inc, sc, inc (24 sts)

Round 4

& Round 5: sc 24 sts

Round 6: sc6, (dec, sc) x4, sc6 (20 sts)

Round 7: sc4, (dec, sc) x4, sc4 (16 sts)

Round 8: sc5, dec, sc, dec, sc6 (14 sts)

Round 9

to Round 12: sc14 sts

FO leaving long end for sewing legs to the body later. Stuff legs.



### ***Bunny's Ears***

back part  
(make 2)

in white color yarn

ch11

Row 1: starting in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook hdc x9, 3hdc in last chain, continue working around chain, hdc x9

ch1, turn

Row 2: hdc x9, inc hdc, x3, hdc, x9

ch1, turn

Row 3: hdc24 sts

FO leaving long end for sewing inner ear part later (count enough yarn to sew around ear and for attaching the ear to the head)

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## ***Bunny's Ear***

front part



in colors of your choice make two  
same or each different color

chain 11

Row1: sc9, 3 sc in the last  
chain st, work around chain,  
sc9  
ch1, turn

Row 2: sc9, inc x3, sc9  
FO, hide ends.

## ***Bunny's Tail***

in white color yarn

leave starting yarn tail little bit longer  
(to be able to tie a knot later)

chain 3

in the third chain stitch make pop  
corn stitch with 5 dc. If you find it  
too small for your bunny, add  
more dc stitches and make tail  
desired size.



FO leave long end for sewing tail on the body later.  
With starting and ending yarn tails tie a knot.

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## Sewing parts together



Sew back and front part of ear together



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## Sew head and body

That should be pretty easy over 24 stitches, equal, both parts. Just make sure the ovals fit each other nicely.

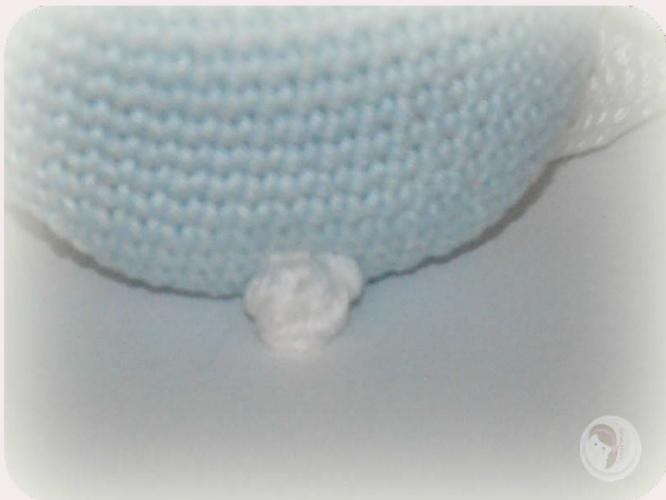
## Arms

Add arms on the side of the body. Two rounds below the joining head round. Sew arms top flatten to the body, paying attention to point oval point on top of each arm to front.



## Legs

Pin legs in between fourth and fifth round counting from the. Leave 5 stitches between each leg. Flatten top of legs vertically compared to shoes and sew them on.



## Tail

Sew the tail centered in between round four and five, on back of Bunny's body. Tail will help Bunny to sit nice and easy, so make sure you place it right way. Pin it before sewing.



## Ears

Sew ears on top of the head. Each ear should start on ends of round one (of the head). I sewed them flattened and straight, but you can twist them a little for special effect. Try before sewing to see what you like better.

It is also optional to add little bit of stuffing inside top of the ears. I

haven't used any, but if you like bunny ears to be puffy and soft, you can add very little stuffing inside.



## Designing the face

If you used safety eyes your eyes are already on. Embroider the nose three rounds below eyes, position in the middle and across three horizontal stitches.

Add little blush on cheeks.

And you Bunny Baby is done.  
Hope you enjoyed making it,  
and sure hope little ones you made it for  
will enjoy it even more!

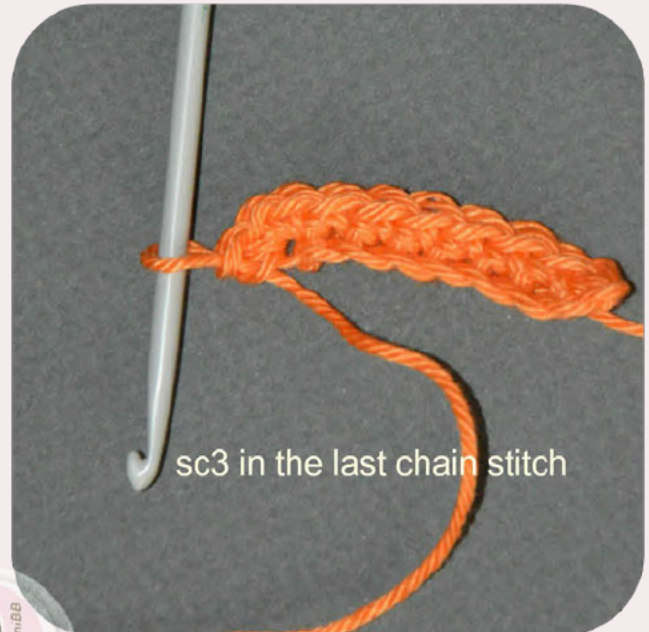


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How to make first round starting with chain.

This photo tutorial was made based on 9 chain stitches.

For the 6 chain that is mentioned in the pattern, use this as your guide, but follow the stitch count written in the pattern.
