This pattern is for Little Yellow Duck brooch you can make in less than one hour!

Materials needed:

- 2 mm crochet hook
- sport weight cotton yarn in yellow
- orange yarn for beak
- stuffing
- needle for sewing
- 6 mm sew on eye, beads or simply embroider eyes directly on the head using black yarn
- safety pin (in size that will fit back of your duckling head vertically)

Abbreviations:

st(s)	stitch(es)
sc	single crochet
ch	chain
inc	increasing stitch, 2sc in one st
dec	decreasing stitch, 2sc together
sl st	slip stitch
blo	back loops only

Duckling Head

(brooch)

Oval head

Start with chain 6

R1: sc4, 3sc in one st, work around chain, sc3, 2 sc in one st (12)

R2: inc, sc3, inc3, sc2, inc2 (18)

R3: sc, inc, sc4, (inc, sc)x3, sc3, inc, sc, inc (24)

R4: sc2, inc, sc5, (inc, sc2)x3, sc3, inc, sc2, inc (30)

R5: sc3, inc, sc6, (inc, sc3)x3, sc3, inc, sc3, inc (36)

R6: sc4, inc, sc7, (inc, sc4)x3, sc3, inc, sc4, inc (42)

R7: sc5, inc, sc8, (inc, sc5)x3, sc3, inc, sc5, inc (48)

R8: blo sc48

R9: sc5, dec, sc8, (dec, sc5)x3, sc3, dec, sc5, dec (42)

R10: sc4, dec, sc7, (dec, sc4)x3, sc3, dec, sc4, dec (36)

R11: sc3, dec, sc6, (dec, sc3)x3, sc3, dec, sc3, dec (30)

R12: sc2, dec, sc5, (dec, sc2)x3, sc3, dec, sc2, dec (24)

R13: sc, dec, sc4, (dec, sc)x3, sc3, dec, sc, dec (18)

stuff the head lightly

R14: dec, sc3, dec, sc2, dec2 (12)

fasten off leaving long tail. Thread tail on the needle and sew the last round closed. Use same thread to sew on the safety pin.

Round Head

R1: sc6 in magic ring

R2: inc6 (12)

R3: (inc, sc) x6 (18)

R4: (inc, sc2) x6 (24)

R5: (inc, sc3) x6 (30)

R6: (inc, sc4) x6 (36)

R7: (inc, sc5) x6 (42)

R8: (inc, sc6) x6 (48)

R9: blo 48 sts

R10: (dec, sc6) x6 (42)

R11: (dec, sc5) x6 (36)

R12: (dec, sc4) x6 (30)

R13: (dec, sc3) x6 (24)

R14: (dec, sc2) x6 (18)

stuff the head lightly

R15: (dec, sc) x6 (12)

R16: dec6 (6)

fasten off leaving long tail. Thread the needle and sew the last round closed. Use same yarn to sew the safety pin on.

Beak

(orange)

Start with chain6

R1: sc4, 3sc in one st, work around chain, sc3, 2 sc in one st (12)

R2-R3: sc12

fasten off leaving long tail for sewing.

Sew the beak one round from the center.

Sew the eyes, one round above from beak edges. Or find the place where you like them to be placed the most.

Hairs:

Attach the yarn on one of the stitches on top of the head.

Ch6, starting from the second stitch from the hook, sl st 5

sl st to next st, ch5, starting from the second stitch from hook sl st 4, sl st to same st on the head and fasten off. Hide ends inside the head.
